

# MARION COUNTY FAIR FERAL HOG HUNTING CONTEST

## GENERAL RULES

1. This contest is open to all legal hunters for the purpose of harvesting feral hogs.
2. Competitor may hunt in any county or parish.
3. For the purposes of this hunt, hogs are defined to be feral, free-ranging, wild hogs which have not been previously held, trapped, pen raised, and released for the purposes of being hunted in this contest and must not have been hunted from within a game fence.
4. The contest will start at 12 A.M. on October 19<sup>th</sup>. Check in will be between 5 - 6 P.M. on October 19<sup>th</sup>. Saturday start time is Friday at 6 P.M. and end at check in on Saturday, October 20<sup>th</sup> at 5 - 6 P.M. You must be in line then.
5. Check-in will be at the Marion County Fairgrounds, located at 130 Kelly Park Rd., Jefferson, Texas from 5 – 6 P.M. on Friday, October 19<sup>th</sup> and again on Saturday, October 20<sup>th</sup> from 5-6 p.m. Hunters may hunt on both days and weigh in on both days. The total number of hogs will determine the winners of main hunt. Side pots for biggest boar and sow are optional with a 100% pay back. Main contest is a 70% payback. Winner of main contest will receive a Montana Silversmith Belt Buckle and cash. Number of entries will determine the number of places paid.
6. An official time keeper / end of line judge will determine the close of check-in.
7. No hogs arriving after close of check-in will be considered for the contest regardless of excuse, calling ahead, or any other unforeseeable circumstance. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
8. Hogs harvested outside of the official contest will not count.
9. All contestants must bring their hunting license to check-in.
10. **ALL HOGS ARE TO BE BROUGHT IN DEAD AND ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE HUNTER TO DISPOSE OF.**
11. Any hogs brought to the Marion County Fair alive will be reported to the Texas Animal Health Commission.
12. Any contestant found to be cheating, attempting to cheat, or in violation of any Texas Game Law will cause disqualification of the individual and forfeiture of any and all entry fees. The perpetrator may also be banned from future contest.
13. There will be no alcohol permitted and no display of weapons on one's person on the check-in premises.
14. Anyone behaving in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner will be asked to leave.
15. Once the final decision of the contest officials are made, the decision is final.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT I, the undersigned \_\_\_\_\_ I hereby waive all claims, release, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Marion County Fair and all its officials, officers, agents and employees in both their public and private capacities, from any and all liability, claims, suits, demands, expenses of litigation, or causes of action which may arise by reason of injury to persons or loss of, damage to or loss of use of any property occasioned by error, omission or negligent act of myself or any other persons with regard to this Agreement and I will at my own cost and expense defend and protect the Marion County Fair against any and all such claims and demands.

I hereby agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Marion County Fair and all of its officials, officers, agents and employees from and against any and all claim, losses, damages, causes of action, suits, and liability of every kind, including all expenses of litigation, including but not limited to court costs and attorneys' fees for death, injury to or debt of any person or loss of, damage to, or loss of use of any property arising out of or in connection with this Agreement. Such indemnity shall apply whether the claims, losses, damages, causes of action, suits, of liability arise in whole or in part from the negligence of the Marion County Fair, its officers, officials, agents or employees. It is the express intention of the parties hereto, both myself and the Marion County Fair, that the indemnity provided for in this paragraph is indemnity by the undersigned to indemnify and protect Marion County own negligence, whether that negligence is the sole or concurring cause of the injury, death or damage.

It is further agreed that the execution of this "Waiver of Liability, Release, Indemnification and Hold Harmless Agreement" will not constitute a waiver by the Marion County Fair of the defense of governmental immunity where applicable, or any other defense recognized by the courts of the State of Texas.
